Instructions

Sample Community Church has partnered with Community Empowerment Research to conduct a survey of our congregation. This questionnaire helps us discern strength, weakness, attitudes, and perceptions in our church.

Completing the survey will likely take a little more than 30 minutes. The goal of this survey is to discover where people are spiritually, what their needs are, how well the church is doing at meeting needs, and what goals people feel are important. The time you give for this survey is very important to our church.

The survey not only asks several sets of questions about our congregation's current ministry and your own involvement, but also seeks your input on pastoral leadership and our vision for our future. Completing this survey ensures that your views have been heard and it will give us a baseline from which to measure whether we are moving in directions that we think are important. We ask that each member of your household over the age of 15 complete the survey.

You may use any pencil or pen to mark your answers. Please answer all questions. If you have any doubts, mark the answer that best represents your thoughts.

Do not put your name on this questionnaire. Your answers to this survey will be treated with complete confidentiality. Our church will receive only aggregate (summarized) results. The responses from each individual will remain with Community Empowerment Research and will not be made public.

When answering this survey, please fill in the appropriate circle or check the appropriate boxes as indicated. Please choose the answer that comes closest to the right answer for you, even if it does not fit perfectly. It is important that we receive input from everyone. Your participation in this survey assures your input on our self-assessment!
